

**ORDER (1) GRANTING JOINT  
MOTION FOR AWARD OF  
ATTORNEYS’ FEES PURSUANT  
TO 28 U.S.C. § 2412, AND  
(2) DENYING AS MOOT  
PLAINTIFF’S MOTION FOR  
AWARD OF ATTORNEYS’ FEES  
PURSUANT TO 28 U.S.C. § 2412**  
  
(ECF Nos. 159, 163)

Presently before the Court are Plaintiff Kaji Dousa’s Motion for Award of Attorneys’ Fees Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2412 (“Pl.’s Mot.,” ECF No. 159) and the Joint Motion and Stipulation re: Award of Attorneys’ Fees and Expenses Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2412 (“Joint Mot.,” ECF No. 163) filed by Plaintiff and Defendant U.S. Customs and Border Protection (“CBP”). Good cause appearing, the Court **GRANTS** the Joint Motion

1 and **DENIES AS MOOT** Plaintiff’s Motion. As agreed between the Parties, under the  
2 Equal Access to Justice Act, 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d), the Court **AWARDS** Plaintiff attorneys’  
3 fees in the amount of \$358,218.20 and expenses in the amount of \$72,988.05, as against  
4 CBP only, subject to any offset allowed under the United States Department of the  
5 Treasury’s Offset Program. Pursuant to the Parties’ stipulation, upon CBP’s payment of  
6 these amounts, all Defendants—including the Department of Homeland Security and  
7 Immigration and Customs Enforcement—shall be released of any obligation or liability to  
8 compensate Plaintiff for her costs, expenses, and legal fees incurred in this action.

9 **IT IS SO ORDERED.**
