President Trump's image is under pressure – even on crime.











#### **Crime Increasing vs Decreasing**


In general, since Donald Trump has taken office, do you feel that crime in the US has increased, decreased, or been about the same?




How much have you seen, read, or heard about Donald Trump's recent deployment of the military to different cities across the country?



In general, do you think it's good or bad for the President to have the power to send the National Guard into American cities?






For each question, please answer whether you think it is an appropriate or inappropriate reason for deploying the National Guard?





### National Guard Deployment – What's Inappropriate

Would you support or oppose the National Guard being deployed to your city?







#### **No Insurrection Act**

The president can legally deploy the military across the country to engage in law enforcement only if he invokes the Insurrection Act, which allows for domestic military deployments to put down violent insurrections that threaten the constitution. 




### National Guard Deployment





#### Initial Ballot

Please tell me whether you agree or disagree with each of the following:

- It would be better to increase funding for local law enforcement rather than spending huge sums of taxpayer money to deploy the military.
- Governors are in command of their states' National Guards, and a president deploying them over a governor's wishes undermines states' rights and the Constitution's separation of powers.
- The National Guard's primary mission is to defend our country from foreign threats and respond to natural disaster. It is not trained or designed to provide local law enforcement.
- Deploying the National Guard to just Los Angeles earlier this year cost over \$134 million. Our government is currently shut down over arguments about funding, and we have a growing national debt. Now is not the time to waste money deploying the National Guard.
  - Members of the National Guard, like all branches of the military are trained to kill in combat, not patrol protests or arrest criminals. Asking the Guard to do something they aren't trained for puts citizens, and themselves at risk.
    - Allowing the President to deploy the National Guard to cities
      over objections of state and local leaders is essentially
      allowing the president to invade parts of our own country. The
      next Democrat could do the same to Republican states. But
      no president has this authority.






### Before + After




